| <u>Southwest</u> | <p>Soil was fertile (able to grow plants)</p> <p>Expert farmers-grew melons, beans, squash and corn</p> <p>Raised sheep for meat</p> | <p>Used cotton from cotton plants they grew</p> <p>Wool from sheep they raised</p> | <p>Pueblos-built from adobe (clay), wood, brush or any natural resource they could find</p> | <p>Water-made irrigation (water) had techniques for farms</p> <p>Wood, leaves, mud, bark were used for houses.</p> |
